

Frank Benson Letter to Lillie Eames #2

Dundee Michigan
Oct 23, 1905

Logan, Utah

My dear Lillie,

I just had dinner so I am full. I haven't heard from home yet. If I don't get a letter soon, I'll start for home a foot.

I feel fine. We held two meetings yesterday. I spoke in both but it is impossible for me to say anything but I make a stager at it.

It seems a year since the night I bid you goodbye and the thoughts of not seeing you for two years seems impossible but it must be. It is hard being away from friends and loved ones but the Lord knows best and I can have health and strength and the spirit of the Lord to attend me while here I will never begrudge the time or money I spend while here.

Sweetheart, my mind is a blank today. I've written you three times since I came here and haven't heard from you yet. If you were out here for a while, you would realize how good it would be to get a letter and especially from one you loved with all your heart as I love you.

Goodbye Darling for this time. The love I have for you my dear, is a love increasing day by day and year by year it keeps steadily increasing.
